IWCG TERMS & CONDITIONS

Acceptance of Terms: By signing an NOA, drawing funds, or otherwise obtaining funds from the 501(c)3 Public Charity Women Funding Women, the recipient acknowledges acceptance of the terms and conditions of the award and is obligated to perform in accordance with the requirements of the award.

Recipients are free to accept or reject the award. Grantees will be required to sign an NOA to signify their understanding of these terms and the acceptance of the IWCG. If the recipient cannot accept the terms, the recipient should notify the appointed Grant Management Officer (GMO) within thirty (30) days of receipt of this award notice. Once an award is accepted by a recipient, the contents of the Notice of Award (NOA) are binding on the recipient unless and until modified by a revised NOA signed by the GMO and/or the President/CEO of Women Funding Women.

Award Expectations: The eligibility and program requirements originally outlined in the NOA must continue to be adhered to as funding goals are implemented. Recipients must comply with the performance goals, milestones, outcomes, and performance reporting as reflected in the NOA and related policy and guidance. Additional terms and/or conditions may be applied to this award if outstanding financial or programmatic compliance issues are identified by Women Funding Women (WFW)

Requirements. The reporting requirements for this award are identified in details on the Reporting Checklist sent to the grantee with the NOA. Failure to comply with these reporting requirements is considered a material noncompliance with the terms of the award. Noncompliance may result in withholding of future payments, suspension, or termination of the current award, and withholding of future awards. A willful failure to perform, a history of failure to perform, or unsatisfactory performance of this and/or other financial assistance awards, may also result in a debarment action to preclude future awards by Federal agencies.

IWCG Usage: Appropriated funds may not be used for items outside of the approved expenditures as they pertain to the recipient's education, business, personal and/or professional advancement, and physical, emotional, and mental wellness. Grantee will be required to request to draw on their award for transactions that are approved under the above expenditure guidelines and limitations set by Women Funding Women. As per the reporting requirements set forth by the granting organization, recipients will submit transaction documentation including, but not limited to, completed invoices and receipts.

Termination: This award may be terminated in whole or in part: By the WFW if a recipient fails to comply with the terms and conditions set forth for the IWCG. In the event of termination, written notification setting forth the reasons for such termination, the effective date, and, in the case of partial termination, the portion to be terminated will be sent to the recipient within 30 days.

Rights in Data and Publications: As applicable, applicants and recipients agree to grant Women Funding Women, it's partners, sponsors, and affiliates the right to use any submitted information including photos, videos, and demographics to further promote the IWCG, support the organization's mission, or advance the organization itself.

Reconciliation and Liquidation: Recipients must liquidate all obligations incurred under an award not later than ninety (90) days after the end of their grant counseling session. After ninety (90) days, all funds and accounts will be locked and drawing privileges will be suspended indefinitely WFW does not approve extensions to the ninety (90) day post-award reconciliation/liquidation period. Therefore, recipients are expected to complete all work and reporting within the approved project period and the aforementioned 90-day post-award reconciliation/liquidation period. Recipients (late) withdrawal requests occurring after the aforementioned periods will be denied.

Future Funding: Applicants who do not receive a grant are eligible to apply to the next available grant or program. Recipients of the IWCG are prohibited to apply for another grant or funding program from IWCG for a maximum of 5 years from the date of last reward. Recipients are, however, welcome to take advantage of any non-monetary resources offered or promoted by Women Funding Women.
